1. [Aid for Animals Charitable Trust](#) - small and medium sized UK charities and established charities abroad, to assist in rescue, rehabilitation, veterinary treatment and either rehoming of rescued animals or provision of permanent sanctuary for those animals that cannot be.
2. [Animal Rescue Foundation](#) – grants to small UK animal charities, with an immediate need for assistance.
3. [Animal Friends Insurance Services](#) – commercial company, but makes grants.
4. [Cadogan Charity](#) - national animal welfare charities in London or Scotland.
5. [Dischma Charitable Trust](#) - UK registered charities concerned with animal welfare, with preference for London and Hampshire.
6. [Dogs Trust](#) - innovative projects that other organisations can learn from, and that contribute towards encouraging responsible dog ownership or humane management of dog populations. But, not UK/Ireland.
7. [Edith Murphy Foundation](#) - national charities and local charitable causes in Leicestershire and the East Midlands to relieve the suffering and care for unwanted animals.
8. [HDH Wills Charitable Trust](#) - registered charities that are concerned with the preservation of wildlife and the environment.
9. [Jean Sainsbury Animal Welfare Trust](#) - animal welfare charities for projects or activities in the UK that benefit and protect animals, relieve the suffering of animals, address the conservation of wildlife or encourage a greater understanding of animals.
10. [John Jackson Charitable Trust](#) - animal welfare, Eastbourne area only.
11. [L E Andrews Charitable Trust](#) – animal welfare charity.
12. [Lush Charity Pot](#) - small volunteer-run grassroots organisations, and particularly campaign groups, working in animal protection in the UK and overseas, with priority for less popular causes that aim to create long-term change and struggle to find funding.
13. [Marchig Animal Welfare Trust](#) - projects worldwide in the field of animal welfare. To protect animals and to promote and encourage practical work in preventing animal cruelty and the relief of animal suffering.
14. [Marjorie Viggars Charitable Trust](#) – UK charitable organisations for projects that address the protection of animals. Typical grant is between £500 and £1,000.
15. [Marsh Christian Trust](#) - UK registered charities that are working in the field of animal welfare.
16. [Network for Animals Charitable Trust](#) – to increase public awareness of animal welfare and environmental concern.
17. [Olsen Animal Trust](#) - mainly international.
18. [People's Trust for Endangered Species - Conservation Insight Grants](#) for scientific researchers and conservationists for work worldwide that is aimed at the preservation of endangered species, either through research or practical field work.
19. [People's Trust for Endangered Species - UK Mammals Grant](#) - for work that relates to the conservation of mammals in the UK, including scientific research, practical habitat management work, reintroduction and monitoring programmes and educational projects.

20. [Pet Plan Charitable Trust](#) - causes both in the UK and abroad; everything from non-invasive research into new life-saving treatments for animals, to donations for animal rehoming charities.
21. [Persula Foundation](#) - animal welfare.
22. [Robert Clutterbuck Charitable Trust](#) - registered charities in England and Wales with a preference for projects in Cheshire and Hertfordshire. Protection and preservation of domestic animal life; and natural history and wildlife.
23. [Rowan Bental Charitable Trust](#) - Grants for charities in Southern England to assist with animal welfare.
24. [Stuart Halbert Foundation](#) - UK registered charities and other charitable organisations for projects that support animal welfare.
25. [Support Adoption for Pets Grant Programme](#) - charities and non-profit organisations in the UK whose main objective is to find homes for pets in the UK and support pet rescues. Grants of between £1,000 and £150,000 are available.
26. [Sylvia Waddilove Foundation UK](#) - registered charities for projects relating to education in organic farming, animal husbandry, veterinary science, animal welfare and animal surgery.
27. [The Animal Foundation Mission](#) - particular focus is on providing help for smaller, UK based animal causes that may struggle to raise sufficient funds to fulfil their objectives through traditional means.
28. [The G D Charitable Trust](#) - registered charities undertaking projects in animal welfare, in England and Wales.
29. [The Kennel Club Charitable Trust](#) - variety of work ranging from research into canine diseases, dog welfare organisations and the promotion of support dogs.
30. [The Lincolnshire Trust for Cats](#) - To relieve the suffering of cats and, in particular, to provide rescue homes and hospital facilities for the reception and care of unwanted cats and the treatment of sick and ill-treated cats.
31. [The R S Macdonald Charitable Trust](#) - grants to help animals that have been abused or are in danger of abuse, and initiatives that reduce the risk of such abuse. Programmes that encourage responsible pet ownership are of particular interest.
32. [Whitley Animal Protection Trust](#) - UK charities carrying out animal welfare activities. Most grants £250 to £25,000.
33. [Whitely Wildlife Protection Trust](#) - grants to individuals undertaking nature conservation projects. Projects may involve practical habitat or species management, research, training, education, awareness raising or campaigning.
