1. [AFTAID - Aid for the Aged in Distress](#) - Indirect financial assistance for older people in distress in the UK who need essential items to make their lives more comfortable.
2. [Ballinger Charitable Trust](#) - charities, voluntary organisations and community groups for projects in the NE of England.
3. [Barchester Healthcare Foundation](#) - small local UK groups and charities to improve the quality of life for older people, where health and/or social care needs cannot be met by the statutory public sector or by the individual.

5. [Charles Hayward Foundation](#) - project and capital, for various programmes, including older people and social and criminal justice.

23. **Norman Barnes Fund** - local charitable organisations working with older residents (over the age of 60) of Rochdale, Castleton, Norden or Bamford who are in need and retired.
24. **Percy Bilton Charity- Grants for Organisations** - UK registered charities with primary objectives to assist older people (aged over 60).
25. **Pople Charitable Trust Grant** - charitable organisations that support older people in Gloucestershire and Somerset.
26. **Proven Family Trust** - charitable organisations that benefit the elderly in Cumbria or Merseyside.
27. **Quartet Community Foundation - Surviving Winter Grants Programme** - small, local voluntary and community groups supporting older people experiencing fuel poverty in the West of England.
28. **Robert McAlpine Foundation** - registered charities in England, Wales and Scotland undertaking projects for the benefit of children, youth, the elderly, social and medical research.
29. **Rowan Bentall Charitable Trust** - small grassroots organisations based and working in the boroughs of Kingston-upon-Thames and Richmond-upon-Thames.
30. **Rowlands Trust** - registered charities in the West and South Midlands.
31. **Shanly Foundation** - causes including the young, the elderly, those with a physical handicap, mental illness, injury or life limiting illness. Berkshire, Bucks, Hamps, Herts, N London, Oxon, and W Sussex.
32. **Simpson Charitable Trust** - charitable organisations in West Sussex that support older people who are suffering from sickness and disability.
33. **Sir James Knott Trust** - charities in NE England. Special consideration is given to charitable activities known to have been of particular interest to Sir James Knott. They include: military organisations, youth clubs, projects to help the elderly, education and training.

35. **Talbot Village Trust** - registered charities, churches or places of education in Poole, Bournemouth, Christchurch, Isle of Purbeck and East Dorset for local capital projects.

36. **The Albert Van Den Bergh Charitable Trust** - Small grants for UK registered charities and institutions that care for older people, children and the disabled.
37. **The Field Family Charitable Trust (Woodlands Trust)** - local charities operating in the West Midlands and London within the boundaries of the M25 - vulnerable young people, between the ages of 13-25, and the Elderly. Outreach, engagement, equipment, furnishings, running costs, helplines.
38. **The Francis Winham Foundation** - registered charities undertaking welfare projects for elderly people in England.
39. **The L and R Gilley Charitable Trust** - charitable organisations that provide services in Devon and Birmingham for the care of the frail elderly in their own homes, including the terminally ill.
40. **The Steve Morgan Foundation** - children and families, people with physical or learning disabilities, the elderly, or those that are socially disadvantaged in North Wales, Merseyside, Cheshire and North Shropshire.
