2. [Asda](#) – provides independent grants and supports locally relevant projects throughout the UK; charities, local good causes and community activity
3. [Budgens](#) – various initiatives.
4. [Co-op](#) – funding for local projects.
5. [Co-op Foundation Space to Connect](#) – enhanced grants, between £30,000 and £50,000. Core costs including staff time for projects that identify, improve and protect community spaces in England.
